Qualitative Research Approaches Action Research

Action research is research that takes place simultaneously while taking action, which is often focused on a localized problem. This type of research engages participants in some way in order to solve a problem. Steps involved in this type of research include: identifying a problem/selecting a focus, reviewing existing knowledge and theory, data collection, reflection/analysis, and taking action based on data. There are several types of action research, including but not limited to participatory action research, practical action research, and critical action research.
